Robson thought the singing and dancing made the play more entertaining. Evie was impressed that everyone had learned their lines!


Freddie liked the message we got from the play about being friends.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS


Well done to everyone for attending school punctually. We know children sometimes are ill and this is a part of life; please let us know as soon as you can if your child will be absent.
