START AND END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Grainthorpe gates open at 08:30 and staff are on the playground to supervise children until 08:45 when the school day begins.

Marshchapel gates open at 08:45 and there is a member of staff on the playground, but the children go in to class from 08:45 onwards. The school day begins at 09:00.

Staff spend time before the gates open preparing for the day. As I'm sure you know, the staff are so dedicated and always strive for the best. Please respect the opening times so we can continue to deliver the amazing curriculum we offer.

BUS CHILDREN

Please remember to wait with your child at the bus pick up point. The bus company advise you to arrive at least 5 minutes before the bus departs <u>and</u> to be waiting for the arrival after school.

Children are told to come in to Marshchapel school if parents are not there - this safety net we have in place works, when an emergency arises and you are late.

Marshchapel children are in class until 3.30pm so if your child is waiting in Marshchapel school for you, please collect them from the office reception area.
